

EQUIPMENT RATING

1. Age
 - a. Number of Points = Current year - model year
2. Use
 - a. 1 point for every 10,000 miles
 - b. 1 point for every 1,000 hours of use
3. Service
 - a. 1 Point = Admin (Assigned to Employee and not a take home vehicle)
 - b. 3 Points = Support (Everyday use, but not used for Emergency Operation and backup to frontline equipment (Reserve))
 - c. 5 Points = Front Line (Capable of Emergency Response Operation)
4. Reliability = Number of times equipment was down for repair last year:
 - a. 0 Points = 0 times
 - b. 1 Point = 1 - 4 times
 - c. 3 Points = 5 - 14 times
 - d. 5 Points = 15+ times
5. Maintenance and Repair Lifetime repair costs are:
 - a. 1 Point = Less than 25% of purchase price
 - b. 3 Points = 25 to 75% of purchase price
 - c. 5 Points = More than 75% of purchase price
6. Condition = This rating is established by the shop foreman:
 - a. 0 Points = Excellent
 - b. 1 Point = Good
 - c. 3 Points = Fair
 - d. 5 Points = Poor
7. Overall rating = The sum of the equipment rating factor points are:
 - a. 0 - 17 points = Excellent
 - b. 18 - 22 points = Good
 - c. 23 - 27 points = Qualifies for Replacement
 - d. 28 < = Needs Immediate Consideration
