## PROCLAMATION

**WHEREAS**, the Village of Schaumburg's (the "Village") continuing efforts to address the critical issues of safety, energy efficiency, water conservation, and resilience in the development and building environment that affects all of our residents and businesses, whether in daily life or in times of natural disaster, provides confidence that our structures are safe and sound; and

**WHEREAS**, the sense of security of our residents and business owners is achieved in part, through the devotion of vigilant public servants and private citizens – building safety and fire prevention officials, architects, engineers, builders, tradespeople, laborers and others in the construction industry – who work year-round to ensure the safe construction of buildings; and

**WHEREAS**, dedicated members of the International Code Council (the "ICC") – use a governmental consensus process that brings together local, state and federal officials with expertise in the built environment to create and implement the highest-quality codes to protect Americans in the buildings where we live, learn, work, worship, play; and

**WHEREAS**, the building codes propagated by the ICC, the most widely adopted building safety, energy and fire prevention codes in the nation, are used by most U.S. cities, counties and states also include safeguards to protect the public from natural disasters such as hurricanes, snowstorms, tornadoes, wildland fires, floods and earthquakes; and

**WHEREAS**, Building Safety Month is sponsored by the ICC, to remind the public about the critical role of our communities' local code officials – who assure the construction and maintenance of safe, efficient and livable buildings; and

**WHEREAS**, the phrase "Building Codes: Driving Growth through Innovation, Resilience and Safety" the theme for Building Safety Month 2024, encourages all Americans to be aware of the importance of building safe and resilient construction; fire prevention; disaster mitigation, potable water safety and conservation; energy efficiency and new efficient technologies in the construction industry; and

**WHEREAS**, Building Safety Month 2024 encourages appropriate steps that all concerned can take to ensure that the places where we live, learn, work, worship and recreate are safe and sustainable, and also encourages us to recognize that countless lives have been saved due to the implementation of safety codes by local and state agencies; and

**WHEREAS**, each year, in observance of Building Safety Month, Americans are asked to recognize efforts to improve building safety and sustainability at home and in the community, and to acknowledge the essential service provided to all of us by local and state building departments, fire prevention bureaus and federal agencies in protecting lives and property.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, I, Tom Dailly, Village President of the Village of Schaumburg, do hereby proclaim the month of May 2024:

### **BUILDING SAFETY MONTH**
